### Honda TreeFund

The Honda TreeFund programme was created in 2004 as a way to offset car emissions. It ensures that for every new Honda sold, ten native trees are funded.

Over 75,000 trees are expected to be funded every year creating a veritable forest.

The trees are planted in association with regional councils all over the country, providing a measurable way to absorb some of the carbon dioxide produced by motor vehicles.

Honda purchasers are invited to donate to Honda TreeFund at the time of purchase and then join in the planting of the trees in conjunction with the Honda Agent Staff and their regional council.

### What is the Waikanae Estuary Care Group Inc?

The Waikanae Estuary Care Group was formed in 2004 through the Greater Wellington Regional Council Take Care programme.

The group was established by a group of local residents who wanted to rid the estuary of the invasive weeds and return this special scientific reserve to its former glory.

The tidal area of the Waikanae Estuary is one of the more significant unmodified areas for indigenous wildlife habitat in the lower North Island.

Its very high biodiversity value as a habitat for wading and migratory birds has led to a large area being protected and gazetted as a Scientific Reserve.

The Waikanae Estuary Care Group Inc. committee is delighted to have plants from the Honda Tree Fund to plant in the estuary.
