Helping Hands - A general road safety resource for new entrants including some basic cycle safety information.

Stepping Out - The programme is designed for 5 - 7 year olds. It aims to encourage and assist children to behave in safe ways as pedestrians and passengers in a traffic environment

Tracks are for Trains - The programme demonstrates safe behaviour at railway stations and level crossings. It comprises lessons for children around three major themes – About Trains, About Tracks, and About Us. The kit is available free of charge to primary and intermediate schools and is distributed by the 120 Police Education Officers throughout the country
