What we've done

What we've noticed

Overall the level of compliance was generally very good with only a small proportion of major non-compliance. Major noncompliance encountered was generally in relation to works being undertaken outside the scope of what had been consented. Minor non-compliance was mainly due to lack of notification to GWRC about works or late/nil submission of records associated with works.

What we'd like to fix or change

For river works not undertaken by GWRC Catchment Management, there are no changes proposed for this monitoring programme at this point.

GWRC Catchment Management has lodged consent application to renew the river maintenance and flood protection operations for eight regional rivers and streams. Catchment Management will continue to operate under their existing consent conditions until the new consents have been processed.
