

All Standing Committees Shall Have Common Responsibilities To

- Advise and make recommendations to **Council** relating to the effective and efficient performance of .the Committee's functions and **responsibilities**, including periodic review of the Committee **Terms** of **Reference**.
- To recommend to the Policy and Finance Committee programmes, priorities and budgets identifying desired outcomes over the ensuing a period of up to 10 years period and the resources considered necessary for the effective and efficient performance of functions for which it is responsible.
- Monitor progress on the **implementation** of those activities and projects contained in the current Business and Annual Plans which are the **responsibility** of the Committee.
- 4.4 Recommend to Council, through the Policy and Finance Committee, any changes in priorities and funding for activities and projects within the Committee's area of responsibility as and when considered **necessary** or appropriate.
- Authorise expenditure for **purposes** set out in the Business and Annual Plans within the limits of the current approved budget and delegations authorised by Council, as set out in the Council's **Delegations** Manual and the current approved plans.
- 4.6 **Evaluate** and report on legislation relevant to the Committee's area of responsibility and make recommendations concerning Bylaws where appropriate.
- Make' recommendations to the Environment Committee on changes considered necessary or appropriate to the Wellington Regional Policy Statement or regional plans relevant to the Committee's functions and responsibilities
- 4.8 Discuss <u>and promote its</u> activities with constituent councils and other public bodies, Government agencies, private sector organisations and the general public.
- 4.9 Set up and terminate subcommittees and working parties where appropriate with specific terms of reference to advise the Committee on matters **relating** to its area of responsibility.
- 4.10 Recommend to **Council** the establishment and termination of joint committees with other authorities to advise or act on matters which, in the Committee's view, **require** or would benefit **from** co-operation.
- 4.11 Nominate, for Council consideration, Committee members or other persons to serve as Council **representatives** on any body or **organisation**, the activities of which are relevant to the Committee's area of responsibility.
- 4.12 Actively promote and ensure compliance with relevant legislation.
- 4.13 Determine those matters delegated to it by Council in accordance with approved policies, management plans and **Bylaws**.
