The Wellington City Council shall monitor air quality in the vicinity of the plant to confirm the absence of faecal coliforms and salmonella originating from the plant. Sampling is to be carried out at least once every six months when wind conditions are predicted to be greater than or equal to 20 knots. The sampling method and locations are to be agreed by the Wellington Regional Council. Tests are to be carried out at a minimum of three sites downwind and three sites upwind of the plant,

with at least one site to be in the vicinity of the Air New Zealand kitchens and one at the level of Kekerenga Street. The other sites are to be located outside of and within 100 metres of the site boundary. The results are to be supplied to the Regional Council at yearly intervals or on request. Should the presence of faecal coliforms or salmonella be measured at any time, the Wellington Regional Council may direct that the applicant revert to sampling at least once every month for six months before returning to the six monthly sampling regime.
