Standing Orders for Emergency Meetings

28. (a) Emergency meetings of Council and its Committees may be called by the Chairperson or, if the Chairperson is unavailable, the General Manager, to deal with matters specified by the Chairperson or General Manager which require shorter notice than normally required.
- (b) The person calling the emergency meeting shall give, or cause some other employee of Council to give, notice of the time and place of the emergency meeting and of the matters to be dealt with by whatever means is reasonable in the circumstances to every member of Council and to the General Manager at least 24 hours before the meeting.
