#### **2.1 Collection of Submissions**

#### **2.2 Origin of Submissions**

The Table below lists the origins of each submitter on the Plan. The usual trend is that the majority of submissions come from Wellington, with the rest of the submissions spread over the rest of the constituencies. The submitter (referred to under 'Other') is a major network utility operator based in Auckland, which distributes and supplies businesses and residents throughout the Region.
