Mr Ibell requested free cycle carriage on commuter trains and buses, adequate space for bicycles on trains, adequate parking for bicycles at railway stations, and easy and safe access for cyclists at railway stations.

A copy of the Cycle Aware Wellington Inc representations were circulated.

Councillor Turver thanked Mr Ibell for his submission and said the Regional Council was now commencing a review of the Regional Land Transport Strategy and would take Mr Ibell's comments into account.
