Individuals will be able to apply to enter a ballot for places on these tours. All conditions applying to groups from clubs and other bona fide organisations visiting the Catchment will apply.
 - (ii) The ratio of rangers/interpreters to visitors is to remain at a minimum of 1:10 during Phase 3, in both the Wainuiomata and the Orongorongo Catchments.
 - (iii) At least one Landcare Ranger will accompany all groups entering the Orongorongo Catchment during Phase 3.
