Extension of the Wellington City Council Emergency Management (Civil Defence) Plan

1. **Purpose**

To seek approval, under Section 35 (2) of the Civil Defence Act 1983, for extending the renewal date of the Wellington City Council Emergency Management Plan.

2. Background

The current Wellington City Council Emergency Management (Civil Defence) Plan expires on 1 November 2002. The existing Plan meets the requirements of the Wellington Regional Council. The current Plan is also consistent with, and gives effect to the operative Regional Civil Defence Plan.

Wellington City Council has requested a one-month extension to the renewal date for its Civil Defence Plan to enable their Council to incorporate on-going changes in Emergency Management into the plan.

This request is made pursuant to Section 36 (3) of the Civil Defence Act, 1983, which reads as follows:

Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a local civil defence plan shall continue to be operative while a new plan is prepared for such period or periods of extension, not exceeding 6 months in total, as may be granted by the regional or united council on the application of the territorial authority.

3. Communication

No further communication is necessary for this report.

4. **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Committee:

(1) **Extends** the current Wellington City Council Emergency Management Plan to 1 December 2002.
