## Information of State Highway 1 improvements between Otaki and Waikanae

As you will be aware Transit New Zealand has been investigating options for long term improvements to State Highway 1 between Otaki and Waikanae. This investigation was commenced in line with our National State Highway Strategy that identified a strategy for major rural improvements *"to construct four-lane median divided expressways in high volume corridors"* of which State Highway 1 Wellington to Levin, via Transmission Gully, is such a corridor.

Traffic volumes on State Highway 1 between Otaki and Waikanae are steadily rising, safety concerns are mounting, and land use is intensifying. Transit's long-term vision to resolve these concerns is to provide a safe and efficient four-lane expressway. This expressway would have limited direct access on to it. Instead, there would be interchanges to enter and exit the highway.

During the last few years, Transit has been carrying out preliminary consultation with the public and interested and affected people on what should be done about this, through open days, newsletters, surveys and meetings. We have also investigated many possible improvements and highway routes.

We have now identified a preferred option for improving the highway and are about to begin consulting with all interested and affected people, to decide whether or not to go ahead with this.

A public announcement on the preferred option was made this week.

Please find attached schematics of the broad options considered north and south of the Otaki River. I also include the Preferred Option Route Plan showing the general form of the new road and the anticipated extent of associated designation.


Construction of any highway change, if any were progressed, is unlikely to begin for at least 10 years. While this project is not yet specifically included in the Wellington Regional Land Transport Strategy it does come within the Western Corridor plan. The Preferred Option will address all current roading needs and issues associated with this corridor. It also provides the potential for addressing currently identified deficiencies for bus and rail users.


