Process for Consideration of Submissions

1. Purpose

To propose a process to consider oral and written submissions to the Hutt Corridor Plan and recommend to the Regional Land Transport Committee those proposals that should be included in the Hutt Corridor Plan.

2. This Meeting

2.1 Submissions and other documents

Two separate volumes containing all submissions have been circulated to Subcommittee members. Also volumes containing replies to submissions and a statement by Anthony Brennand are enclosed separately with this report.

2.2 Late submissions

As this being the first formal meeting of the Hearing Subcommittee, the procedure to deal with late submissions could not be set earlier. It is therefore recommended to the Subcommittee that they accept late submissions.

2.3 Oral submissions

The primary purpose of this meeting is to hear the people who wish to make an oral submission in support of their written submission. It is proposed that each person or group should be given the opportunity to speak to their written response (but not to read it in full).

It is the time for Committee members to listen but there will be an opportunity for member's questions, particularly with the aim of clarifying points raised in the submissions. Two separate volumes containing all submissions have been circulated to Subcommittee members.

2.4 Written submissions

The meeting should consider all written submissions in turn regardless of whether or not an oral presentation has been made.

3. The Next Stage

The next stage is to adopt for recommendation to the Regional Land Transport

Committee the Hutt Corridor Plan.

3.1 It may be necessary to make some changes to the Hutt Corridor Plan to reflect

the views of the Subcommittee with respect to submissions.

3.2 Then the revised corridor plan proposals should be sent to all implementing agencies for their comments to the Regional Land Transport Committee on the

revised plan.

3.3 A meeting of the Regional Land Transport Committee will be held at this stage

to consider the recommendations of the Subcommittee.

4. Recommendations

1. That the Subcommittee:

(a) receives this report, the submissions, replies to submissions and the

statement from Anthony Brennand.

(b) hears the oral submissions.

2. That, having heard the oral submissions, the Subcommittee should

consider all written submissions including late submissions.

3. Recommends any changes required for inclusion in the Corridor Plan.

4. Provides a report to the Regional Land Transport Committee.
