Consequently, after discussion with the Chair of the Environment Committee, I have asked the Utility Services Division to prepare a report for the next meeting of the Utility Services Committee.

## 5. Dairy and Clean Streams Accord

Representatives from Fonterra are coming to talk to staff on 25 July 2003. We hope to gain a better understanding of the implications for this Council and, after the meeting, we will see how we can best organise ourselves to meet any demands of the Accord
