Minor Project Construction Priorities

1. Purpose

The purpose of this report is to recommend priorities for the construction of minor projects.

2. Background

Minor projects are defined in Transit's terminology as block programme projects. These have a construction cost less than three million dollars. This year Transit has supplied a list of 12 projects in alphabetical order. The list is:

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Summary descriptions of these projects are shown in **Attachment 2**.

Most projects in this category were considered by the Committee last year. Subsequent to Transit supplying this list it was confirmed that the Waiohine Bridge replacement is now committed so there is no need to consider its priority.

This year Transit have added two new projects (Maoribank to Owen St new streetlighting & Waikanae weigh station). Also, there are now three proposed projects in the block programme seeking to expand the Active Traffic Management System from its current coverage of the Ngauranga Gorge to the Terrace Tunnel and Petone.

3. Additional projects

The Technical Working Group (TWG) considered the following 7 additions were necessary to this category:

Most of the additional projects were considered in this programme last year but because of their low ranking have not been brought forward into this year's list. The TWG considers that all these projects have merit, but more at a local level rather than being strategically significant. Nevertheless, they should remain on the active lists as improvements at the sites would be very beneficial.

The project 'Otaihanga intersection safety improvements' was added by the TWG in response to concern about the very poor safety record at this site. While Transit is currently investigating improvement options, funding should be included in the programme to ensure action can be taken as soon as solutions are agreed.

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4. Technical ranking

The TWG met on three occasions (19 February, 4 and 8 March) to complete this year's technical process. The method used to achieve the recommended rankings was the Transport Package and Project Prioritisation Method as set out in report 04.152. The technical scores are shown in **Attachment 1**.

5. Discussion

Generally the project rankings are similar to those adopted last year. The two significant exceptions are the 'Maoribank Owen St & Paremata – Johnsonville new streetlighting' projects. Last year the Committee agreed to the principle that new work should be undertaken in preference to upgrading work as greater benefits accrued when lighting was established as opposed to being marginally upgraded. The Committee may again feel it is appropriate to raise these projects' ranks from 10 & 12 respectively to above 6.

6. Communications

There is nothing to communicate as a result of determining priorities for recommendation to Transit's current consultation process.

7. Recommendations

That the Committee adopts the following priorities for recommendation to Council and for subsequent submission to Transit New Zealand:
