Access Planning Manager's Report - Work in Progress

1. Purpose

To update the Committee about the work of the Access Planning team.

2. Comment

2.1 Regional Land Transport Strategy review

2.1.1 CBD Corridor study

A Terms of Reference has been developed and it is the matter of another report on this agenda.

2.1.2 Key policies and assumptions

Initial work has been completed and this is the matter of a separate report to the Committee. Further consideration of this topic will also occur at a workshop for the Committee on 1 July 2004.

2.1.3 Regional Pedestrian Strategy

This has been developed by a technical group and has completed its consultation phases. The strategy is the subject of a separate report that seeks the Committee's consideration of submissions and adoption of the amended strategy.

2.1.4 Regional Road Safety Strategy

Again a technical group has developed this. It is also the matter of a separate report seeking the Committee's agreement to release the draft strategy for consultation.

2.2 Cycle strategy implementation

2.2.1 Regional cycle maps

Terralink has been engaged to develop and produce cycle route maps for the region. There will be three maps covering:

- Wellington / Wellington CBD
- Hutt Valley / Wairarapa
- Porirua / Kapiti

Distribution of the maps will commence early in the next financial year.

2.2.2 Strategic cycle network review

Bullen Consultations have completed a review of the strategic cycle network and have recommended development priorities. This will now be circulated to RCAs and discussed at the next Regional Cycle Forum.
