Wholesale Water Levy 2004/5 and End of Year Adjustment Levy 2003/4

1. Purpose

To set the wholesale water levy for 2004/5 and the end of year adjustment levies for 2003/4.

2. Background

As is normal practice, the Council consulted with its water supply customers (the four metropolitan city councils) and the community about the water supply levy for 2004/5. The proposed Annual Plan outlined that the levy for the 2004/5 financial year would be the same as the levy for the current year.

Presentations on the proposed levy have been made to Upper Hutt and Wellington City Councils. The presentation to Porirua City Council is scheduled for Wednesday 18 June. Hutt City Council decided a presentation was unnecessary.

3. Events Occurring Since the Proposed Annual Plan was Approved

3.1 Financial projections

Since finalisation of the Proposed Annual Plan, no changes have been made other than a minor change to the methodology for calculating the debt balances in the out years of the nine year programme.

This has the effect of increasing the debt balance in 2012/13 by \$400,000 to \$56M. Attachment 1 shows the extended debt projections and impact on debt of various alternate levy reductions/increases given current projections.

3.2 Submissions

It is pleasing to record that no issues have resulted from consultation with our customers or the public.

4. Proposed 2004/5 Wholesale Water Levies

The proposed levy for 2004/5, as contained in the Council's proposed Annual Plan is the same as the current year's levy.

If this position is approved, the levy for the 2004/5 financial year will be \$25,623,531 GST inclusive, the same as for 2003/4.

5. Proposed End of Year Adjustment Levies for 2003/4

Because the percentage consumption assumed for each city in setting the 2003/4 levies a year ago differed from the actual consumption, year end adjustments are required. Consumption is based on the metering year that finished at the end of March 2004. Table 2 is the end of year adjustments.
