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# **Divisional Manager's Report - Catchment Management**

The main projects which I am staying in touch with are:

- The Waiwhetu project. The last Waiwhetu Stream Advisory Committee • meeting was very long, and a bit bumpy! We will try and keep the information provided to the upcoming 30 May meeting more concise and manageable. I have asked John Eyles, the project manager, to give you (Landcare Committee) a briefing on the project progress, current issues and the proposed WSAC meeting agenda for 30 May.
- The analysis of the two alignment options for the new Chrystalls • Extended stopbank.

- Ensuring that the Mangaroa River and Pauatahanui flood hazard investigations are completed and ready to be presented to the Committee at the June meeting.
- The follow up work to finalise the Waitohu Stream project. In particular the report back to the Committee about implementing the various recommendations in the summary report.
- The Hutt/Boulcott stopbank feasibility study. I aim to attend the next project team meeting to ensure I am fully briefed on progress with this important project.

Overall the Flood protection team continues to make good progress with most of this years work objectives.
