

Upper Hutt local bus service changes (effective 29 June 2006)

1. Removal of all Sunday services from Route 112 Te Marua – these services carry an average of 3 passengers per trip overall. An alternative option for those passengers is to use the Route 110 at Emerald Hill or Brown Owl.
2. Removal of 1 weekday trip at 6.52pm from Upper Hutt to Te Marua (Route 112) carrying an average of 3 passengers per trip. The latest service is now at 6.32pm
3. Reduction of frequency from 15 minutes to 30 minutes on Route 110 between Upper Hutt Station and Emerald Hill (rest of the service remains at a 15 minute frequency). Actual passenger numbers for this leg of the journey are not available given that they form part of the overall journey however anecdotal evidence shows that these trips are very lightly loaded.
4. Removal of 1 weekday return trip at 6.51pm from Upper Hutt to Totara Park and 6.59pm from Totara Park to Upper Hutt (Route 111) carrying an average of 3 passengers to Totara Park and 0 passengers in the other direction. The latest trips are now 6.31pm and 6.39pm respectively.
5. Removal of 1 weekday trip at 6.50pm from Trentham to Upper Hutt (Route 114) carrying an average of 1 passenger per trip. The latest trip is now at 6.25pm.
6. Removal of 1 weekday trip at 7.00pm from Upper Hutt to Pinehaven (Route 115) carrying an average of 1 passenger per trip. The latest trip is now at 6.05pm.
