That an interim letter be sent to submitters advising them of a delay in the finalisation of the Regional Land Transport Strategy and Regional Passenger Transport Plan as a result of changes needing to be made to those documents to better reflect the submissions received.

There was substantial discussion on the need for the Council's Annual Plan for 2007/08 to continue to progress passenger transport projects, and to ensure the Annual Plan is aligned with what is happening as a consequence of the Passenger Transport Plan submission process.
