# Policies on the appointment and remuneration of directors of Council organisations, and the appointment of non-elected members to Council committees and subcommittees, and advisory groups

### 1. Purpose

To revise the policy on the appointment and remuneration of directors of Council organisations, and to establish policies on the appointment of non-elected members to:

- Council committees and subcommittees, and
- independent advisory groups.

## 2. Significance of the decision

The matters for decision in this report do not trigger the significance policy of the Council or otherwise trigger section 76(3)(b) of the Local Government Act 2002.

# 3. Background

There is a need to update the appointment and remuneration of directors of Council organisations, and to establish policies on the appointment of non-elected members to:

- Council committees and subcommittees, and
- independent advisory groups.

At its meeting on 27 September 2007 the previous Council recommended the draft policies, as set out in the attachments to this report, for adoption by the incoming Council.

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#### 4. Comment

It is appropriate for the Council to have in place policies outlining the procedures to be applied to the making of appointments. This report proposes a generic process for such appointments made up of the following elements:

- clarity of purpose of appointment and competencies (skills and experience) sought;
- identification of candidates;
- evaluation of candidates and selection of preferred candidate; and
- Council or committee decision.

It is proposed that these elements will apply to all appointments, but the nature of their application will vary according to:

- whether the appointment is to a Council committee or subcommittee, Council organisation, or advisory group;
- any applicable Terms of Reference, resolution or statutory direction, which requires variation to the process; and
- the nature of the particular vacancy.

This proposal has the advantages of:

- streamlining the appointment process;
- highlighting requirements specific to the appointment; and
- ensuring statutory compliance with the Local Government Act 2002, by ensuring that appointments of non-elected members meet the criteria of the position and follow a robust selection process.

If it is considered that a substantive variation to the generic process should be applied in respect of a particular set of appointments, the variation should be formally resolved in a Council or committee meeting. Where possible, appointments should be considered in a public excluded portion of a meeting.

A key aspect of the process is a Nominations Evaluation Group, which identifies potential candidates, evaluates and recommends a preferred candidate for committee or Council approval. It is proposed that the Nominations Evaluation Group be made up as follows:
