PEFER 01 Hedging the Council's exposure to adverse movement in the price of oil

That the Committee recommends that Council:

- 1. Receives the report.
- 2. *Notes the content of the report.*
- 3. Approves the addition of oil price hedges and options to the list of approved risk instruments for Greater Wellington under its Treasury Management Policy.
- 4. Authorises the Chief Financial Officer to enter into oil price hedges and/or options if deemed appropriate and subject to the following conditions:

- (i) Any hedges and/or options taken out shall not exceed a total of 15,000 barrels of Singapore Gasoil.
- (ii) The maximum term of any hedge contract and/or option, once it becomes operational, shall not exceed 12 months.
- (iii) Contracts shall only be entered into with counterparties who have a credit rating of at least A from Standard and Poor's.
- (iv) Reports to the Committee on a quarterly basis or at the following meeting if any oil hedges or options are undertaken.

That the Committee notes changes above, and **recommends** that Council reviews this approval on an annual basis.

Both the substantive motion and the amendment were **passed** unanimously.
