Release of the information contained prejudice in the report would be likely to prejudice the commercial position of the tenderer as it would reveal their protect information that, if tender strategy and details of their released, would be likely to operational methodology. In the circumstances, this is considered information, and to enable unreasonable given the competitive environment they operate in. Their competitors could use this information to undercut them.

Release of the information would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the Council in carrying on contract negotiations.

Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of the particular information above public in proceedings of the meeting that would override the identified prejudice.

The information contained in this (2)Forestry Annual Report report relates to Greater Wellington's and Proposals relationship with contractors. The report outlines financial terms of these contracts. Having this part of the meeting open to the public would disadvantage the Council's commercial activities as it would reveal commercial financing arrangements. Greater Wellington has been unable to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice
