Māori Constituency - Ara Tahi position

As agreed at the Ara Tahi meeting on 24 June, Ara Tahi has considered the matter of the establishment of a Māori Constituency for the region for the 2010 election. This is a very important kaupapa for mana whenua and we welcome the opportunity to provide advice and support to Council.

Following a robust discussion at our most recent Technical Workshop Ara Tahi has decided to recommend that the Council do not consider establishing a Māori Consistency at this time.

In reaching this decision a broad range of view points were put forward, all of which referenced the recent establishment of Iwi representatives on Council Committees as a significant development in Iwi representation in the region. There was a clear message from all parties that the establishment of these positions is a priority for Ara Tahi for the remainder of this Council term. Ara Tahi is less conclusive on the substantive issue of whether this is the appropriate time to progress a Māori constituency. Given a lack of consensus we agreed that we should defer any decision until the next opportunity.

Once again we thank you for engaging us on this very important matter.
