Divisional Manager's Report

1. Purpose

3. Air Quality and progress toward compliance with the National Environmental Standard for Air

As Councillors are aware, we have begun to focus on work in relation to air quality on the Masterton airshed. We are now at a point where we are looking for some guidance from the committee around options for the development of an Action Plan for the Wairarapa airshed. The paper at item six on the agenda provides a range of options for discussion around how emission levels in the Masterton airshed could be reduced to ensure compliance with the National Environmental Standard for Air.

4. Field Trip

At the conclusion of the meeting, we will be taking members on a field trip around various sites in the Carterton area. We will be looking at aspects of our monitoring work and also at areas were the impacts of intensive land use are significant.

The trip should take no more than 2 hours, door to door; councillors should expect to be back at the Masterton office no later than 3.00pm.
