Divisional Manager's report

1. Purpose

To inform the Committee about activities that promote the sustainable management of the region's natural and physical resources by overseeing the Council's regulatory responsibilities in relation to resource management and harbour navigation and safety.

2. Managers' reports

3. Resource Management (Simplifying and Streamlining) Amendment Bill

You will be aware that the above Bill was introduced into Parliament in February, delivering on the Government's promise to introduce legislation to the House to amend the Resource Management Act within 100 days of the formation of the new Government. These changes form the Government's "Phase One" reforms to the RMA. "Phase Two" reforms are expected later this year.

The development of the legislation was assisted by a Technical Advisory Group which consisted of environmental and planning specialists, lawyers, businessmen and a local government representative.

We are currently preparing a GW submission to the Select Committee, with submissions closing on 3 April. Our submission is being developed collaboratively with Local Government New Zealand, and other Regional Councils throughout the country. I will highlight our initial thinking around the key aspects of the Bill at the meeting.

I have attached the overview of the "Phase One" Reforms for your information as **Attachment 2**.
