### General subject Reason for passing this resolution in relation to each matter

This report contains recommendations regarding the preferred appointment of a provider to carry out the WRS review. The preferred supplier has not been chosen and no contract has yet been entered into. Release this information would disadvantage Greater Wellington if further negotiations were to take place as it would reveal the Greater Wellington's negotiation strategy.

The information in the report also relates to the pricing strategy of the recommended candidate. Release of the information contained in the report would be likely to prejudice the commercial position of a candidate as it would reveal their tender strategy. Competitors could use this information to their advantage (given the competitive environment in which tenderers operate).

Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override these prejudices.

#### Ground under section 48(1) for the passing of this resolution

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason withholding would exist under 7(2)(i)section and section 7(2)(b)(ii)the of Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e to enable Greater Wellington to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, negotiations and to protect information where the making of available of that information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied the information).

It is necessary to withhold this document to enable Greater Wellington to carry on commercial activities without prejudice or disadvantage. Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure this of particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason withholding would exist under section 7(2)(h) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e to enable Greater Wellington to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, commercial activities).
