Report on the Economic Wellbeing Committee Meeting held on 5 May 2011

1. Purpose

To inform Council about the meeting of the Economic Wellbeing Committee that took place on 5 May 2011.

2. Significance of the decision

The matters for decision in this report do not trigger the significance policy of the Council or otherwise trigger section 76(3)(b) of the Local Government Act 2002.

3. Report

The General Managers' report contained updates on a number of public transport matters, including progress with developing new rail contracts and a summary of Metlink Service Centre customer feedback for the first quarter of the calendar year. The Committee asked for a report at the next meeting outlining the process for dealing with customer feedback.

Flood protection updates were provided for the Boulcott Hutt stopbank (tenders and land access agreement); Wainuiomata flood hazard mapping and Wairarapa river Scheme meetings.

PE report –the Committee was presented with the outcomes of the investigation into the Tawaha Floodway drainage issues within the Lower Wairarapa Valley Development Scheme (LWVDS). It was decided that the report should remain on the table until further discussions with the LWVDS Committee at its scheduled AGM, and then reconvene at a later date to progress the matter.
