Water Supply Annual Report

1. Purpose

To obtain the Committee's approval to publish the Water Supply Annual Report for 2010-11 to coincide with publication of the Council's Annual Report..

2. The decision-making process and significance

2.1 Significance of the decision

The Greater Wellington Water Supply Annual Report captures the achievements and challenges for the wholesale water supply operations for the year ended 30 June 2011. It is supplementary to the GW Annual Report and provides our city council customers and other stakeholders with a more detailed account of work conducted throughout the year.

4. Comment

Once again, poor weather contributed to lower water consumption throughout the year. However, the trend of declining water use is also due to city councils' efforts in leak detection and their support of our ongoing water conservation programmes.

Investigations of an alternative water storage site "Lake 3" commenced during the year, as did the project to strengthen and upgrade the Stuart Macaskill Lakes. The report notes several other achievements, all of which demonstrate an ongoing story of effective business management and innovative service delivery for GW Water.

Audit New Zealand are undertaking an audit of the financial results in the Water Supply Annual Report. At the time of writing we were not certain whether the audit would be completed by 7 September.

5. Communication

The Water Supply Annual Report will be posted to our customers and other relevant stakeholders identified in our database and a copy will be made available on our website.

Media releases will be issued to highlight key achievements and to indicate how to obtain a copy of the report.
