# Increase in the director fee for the Chair of WRC Holdings Limited

## 1. Purpose

To increase the director fee for the Chair of WRC Holdings Limited.

## 2. The decision-making process and significance

The matter requiring decision in this report has been considered by officers against the requirements of Part 6 of the Local Government Act 2002.

#### 2.1 Significance of the decision

Part 6 requires Greater Wellington to consider the significance of the decision. The term 'significance' has a statutory definition set out in the Act.

Officers have considered the significance of the matter, taking the Council' significance policy and decision-making guidelines into account. Officers recommend that the matter be considered to have low significance.

Officers do not consider that a formal record outlining consideration of the decision-making process is required in this instance.

# 3. Background and comment

In accordance with the Council's policy on the appointment and remuneration for directors of council organisations the Chair of WRC Holdings Limited is currently paid a fee for their role.

The current fee of \$19,000 per annum was determined by the Council, as sole shareholder of WRC Holdings Limited, to be congruent (when added to the salary that the Chair receives as a councillor) with the salary payable to a Chair of a Council committee.

In May 2012 the Council adopted a remuneration proposal, which was submitted to, and subsequently approved by, the Remuneration Authority. The approved remuneration set an increase of 0.57% uniformly for all positions.

The current total salary for the Chair of WRC Holdings Limited is, as a result of the increase, now below the amount that would be received were the Chair of the company a Chair of a Council committee.

In order for the total salary of the Chair of WRC Holding Limited to be congruent with the salary of a committee Chair the current director fee for this role will need to be increased from \$19,000 per annum to \$19,107 per annum.

It is recommended that this increase take effect from 1 July 2012.

- 3. As sole shareholder of WRC Holdings Limited **resolves** as a special resolution by way of the written resolutions contained within **Attachment** 1 to authorise the payment of \$19,107 per annum to the director fee paid to the Chairperson of WRC Holdings Limited with effect from 1 July 2012.
- 4. Authorises the Chief Financial Officer and any Councillor to sign the attached written resolutions of the sole shareholder (Attachment 1).
