Greater Wellington Regional Council has not been able identify a public interest disclosure favouring of particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice to the insurers' commercial position.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(b)(ii) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e. to protect information where the available making of information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of person who supplied or is the subject of the information).

The report contains information relating to Greater Wellington Regional Council's (GWRC) investment in CentrePort Limited. Release of this information would be likely to prejudice CentrePort Limited's commercial position. GWRC has not been able to identify favouring public interest disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice to their commercial position.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(b)(ii) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e. to protect information where the making available of that information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of person who supplied or is the subject of the information).

4. Masterton Office Property Update

The information contained in this report relates to Greater Wellington Regional Council (GWRC) entering in to an agreement to relocate staff to a new portable building on the Chapel Street site, the terms of which have yet to be negotiated. Having this

Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override his privacy.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(a) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e to protect the privacy of natural persons).

6. Confirmation of restricted public excluded minutes of the Chief Executive Employment Review Committee August 2013

These minutes contain information relating to the Chief Executive's performance for 2012/13. Release of this information would prejudice David Benham's privacy by 15 disclosing details of his performance agreement with the Council. Greater Wellington Regional Council has not been able public identify a interest favouring disclosure ofthis particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override his privacy.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason for withholding would exist under sections 7(2)(a) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e to protect the privacy of natural persons).

7. Forestry cutting rights sale confirming parties to go forward to due diligence

Certain information contained in this report relates to potential sale of forestry cutting rights. Release of this information would be likely to harm the negotiating position of disclosure of information for Greater Wellington Regional which
