- 5. Notes that methyl bromide is a highly toxic, ozone depleting and invisible gas that can travel substantial distances if recapture technology is not used, and it is released directly into the environment after fumigation.
- 6. Notes that CentrePort, and the Regional Council, have a responsibility under the Health and Safety in Employment Act to take all practical steps to ensure the safety of employees and others in the workplace, and a duty, under section 12 of the act, to ensure that employees are provided with information about all hazards they might be exposed to, and the steps they may take to minimise their exposure to hazards.
- 7. Requires CentrePort, through Port Investments Limited, to amend the environmental performance targets in its Statement of Corporate Intent, to ensure that port workers, Regional Council staff, people who work in buildings that are located on the wharves, and any other persons living or working in the vicinity of the port, are publically notified of any scheduled log fumigation taking place on the wharf, at least 24 hours prior to the event.
