Hi James,

The Carterton District Council considered the Waiohine FMP situation at its meeting yesterday afternoon and resolved as follows –

- 1. That the Council does not endorse any particular proposal for enhanced flood protection from the Waiohine River at this point.
- 2. That the Greater Wellington Regional Council be advised that this Council considers the 'local' funding for any enhancements to the Waiohine River flood protection should be funded along similar lines to the existing rating classification scheme, i.e. that costs be apportioned to those properties that benefit from the proposals through a targeted rate.

As indicated above, the Council considered that it shouldn't support any particular proposal at present and that costs should be met in relation to the benefit to individual properties, especially in the rural areas.
