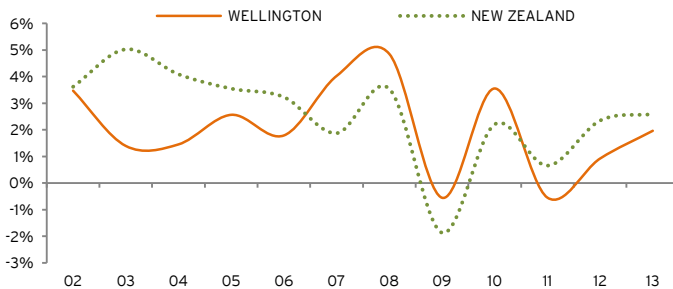

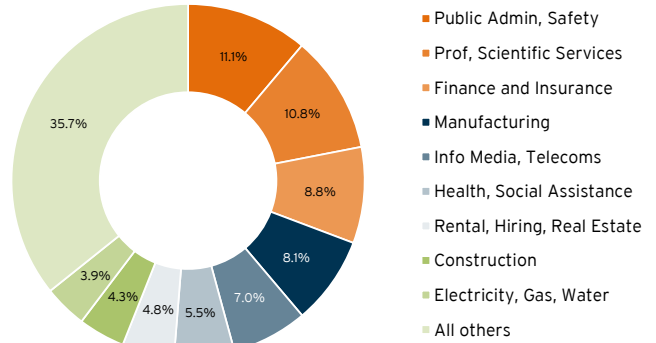

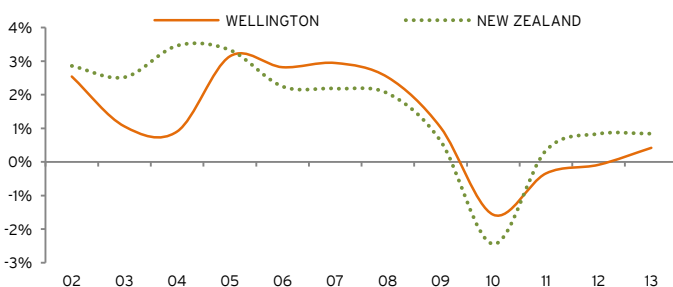

Employment growth: 2002-2013



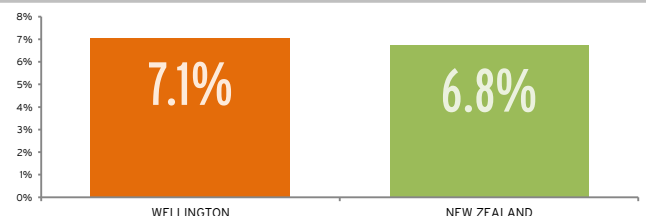

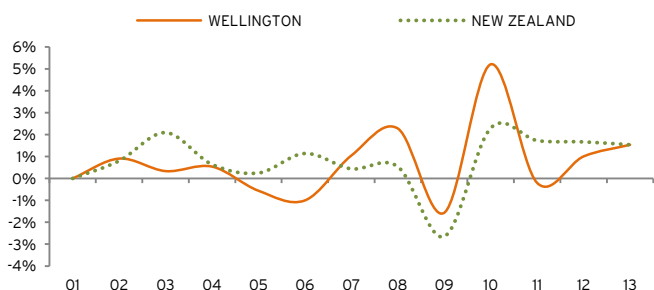

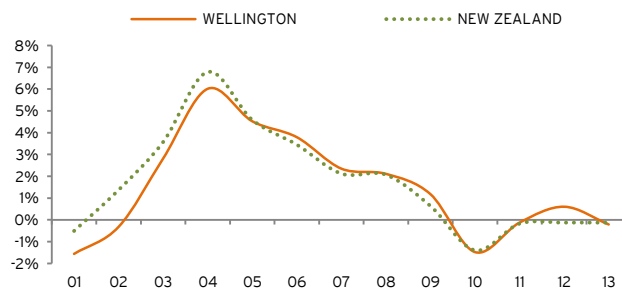

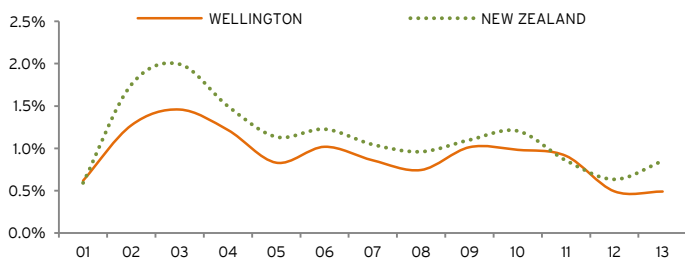

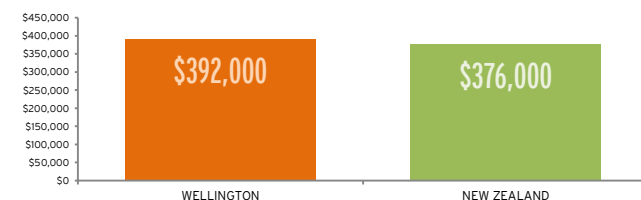
