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Decisions on non-notified resource consent applications

1. Purpose

To report on decisions made under delegated authority on non-notified resource consent applications. This report covers the period 22 September 2012 to 2 November 2012.

2. Consents processed

A total of 38 resource consents were approved in this period. This compares with 68 consents that were approved for the same period last year. Three applications were returned as incomplete under Section 88.

3. Consent trends

The only clear trend common for this time of year, was an increase in land use consents for the construction of water bores and other stream works/ crossings.

3.1 Non-notified consent of interest

Petone Sand Processing Plant – Lower Hutt, Wellington

Winstone Aggregates Limited was granted a suite of renewal consents associated with the ongoing operation of their sand processing plant on the foreshore of the Hutt River, Petone. These consent 'compliment' the ones held by Greater Wellington Flood Protection to dredge bed material from the mouth of the Hutt River to maintain its flood carrying capacity (consent WGN110149). The dredged material is processed at Winstones Plant where the sand portion of this material is removed for use in the construction industry. The consent granted to Winstones includes a coastal water take and coastal discharge.
