I refer to your request for information dated 1 July 2022, which w s received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on 1 July 2022. You have equested the following:

"Please provide actual costs on implementing Snapper on the Johnsonville Line.

Also please provide cost estimates for implem nting Snapper on all other train lines in the wellington network."

Greater Wellington's response follows:

The cost of implementing Snapper on Rail on the Johnsonville line was \$3.07 million. Many of these costs, such as those incurred to undertake civil works or removing paper tickets from the network, will not need to be reincurred when Greater Wellington transitions to the National Ticketing Solution.

The cost of imp ement ng Snapper on Rail on the rest of the network is estimated to be \$7.9 million. Again, many of t ese costs, such as those incurred to undertake civil works or removing paper tickets from the network, will not need to be reincurred when Greater Wellington transitions to the National Ticke ing Solu ion.

If you have any concerns with the decision(s) referred to in this letter, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.
