"... we request meanwhile, that the Council please provides Item1 of our request which must be readily accessible in its accountancy system.

Item 1. *Legal costs which include total invoices (specific to the request) in your council debtors ledger, for your legal Council DLA Piper NZ.*

It is for the EXTRA council LEGAL costs to date, SPECIFIC to establishing rules for Titahi Bay Beach, throughout your PNRP planning and appeal process to the point of Environment Court Order ENV-2019-WLG-000121, 31 March 2021, followed by corrections to your various Map 35 publications."
