Request for information 2023-301

I refer to your request for information dated 7 December 2023, which was received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on 8 December 2023. You have requested the following:

"On behalf of The Martinborough Star, I wish to access the results, relevant reports and commentary resulting from the aerial aquifer survey carried out by helicopter earlier in 2023. Any council staff recommendations arising from the material above is also sought by this request."

Greater Wellington's response follows:

The Ruamāhanga Airbourne Electomagnetic Survey (SkyTEM) was flown over the entire Ruamāhanga Valley and was completed on 3 March 2023. GNS Science Te Pū Ao is currently processing the huge amount of raw data collected during the survey. The processing, inversion, and interpretation of the data will take about two years.

Therefore, we are refusing your request under section 17(g) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) on the basis that the information requested is not held by Greater Wellington and we have no grounds for believing that the information is either held or connected with the functions, of another local authority, or a department, or Minister of the Crown or organization.

A 3D lithological model of the Ruamāhanga Valley will be available to the public in December 2024.
