## **Request for information 2025-141**

I refer to your request for information dated 30 April 2025, which was received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on 30 April 2025. You have requested the following:

- The number of buses with bike racks installed
- The number deemed non-complaint with Rule

## Greater Wellington's response follows:

There are 474 buses on the Metlink fleet fitted with bike racks, of these buses 119 were considered uncompliant and in need of modification to be compliant with the Land Transport Rule: Vehicle Lighting 2004.

We are working with operators to return the bike racks to service on 01 July 2025.

If you have any concerns with the decision(s) referred to in this letter, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.
